How to internationally deal with the intangible values of our national university education?

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Conclusion

- International academic cooperation is a challenge to our national university education.
- Many of its procedures are not codified and many of its values are intangible.
- Its processes can not easily be transferred or exported to give the same results elsewhere.
- We are confronted with the question of what system of higher education follows after the European system in the 19th and the United States system in the 20th century.
- In our internal discussions, I believe, it is necessary to take a global view.


