
- Dissemination of the scientific culture of informatics

- Spreading in school the knowlegde of informatics as scientific discipline
- Est. 2020 (jun.2017 WG), 36 Nodes, 101 researchers



Programma il Futuro

- Since 2014 spreading knowledge of Informatics as scientific discipline in schools and raising awareness on digital technologies
- Based on Code.org material, with lesson plans and supporting videos in Italian, plus webinars and a yearly national competition for classes
- 40K teachers, 3M students, 90% schools involved

Bebras

- Competition for teams in school (9-18 yrs old) on problems inspired as informatics presented as games
 - No specific knowledge is required
 - May be further developed using accompanying material https://bebras.it/explorer.html
- 2024: 4M students in 74 countries, 60K in Italy
- Since beginning (2016-17) 400k total in Italy
- Yearly teachers participation: 1200
- Univ. Milano: material adaptation/translation, support during competition period (first half November)
- Present in a couple of school books

Pinkamp – Girls count!

- Increasing female presence in STEM
- Univ. L'Aquila free 2 weeks camp to support interested girls (16+ yrs old) towards a STEM career
- A multidisciplinary approach (Anthropology, Law, Ethics and Philosophy, Art, Linguistics) so as to shape digital technology developments in a gender balanced way
- 1st wk: lecture, 2nd wk: hands-on
- Since 2019: 300 girls. 90% of them attended follow-up initiatives
- Highly useful to build self-confidence and empowerment

Ragazze Digitali

- Univ. Modena & Reggio Emilia, since 2014
- 1 week free Summer Camps for girls (16+ yrs old)
- Focusing on informatics
- 300 students involved in 15 camps
- Regional focus (Emilia Romagna, recently Lombardia)
- Since 2024 extensions to 11-15 yrs old girls: 140 participants

Social4School

- Game based approach for raising awareness towards social networks and internet content
- Interaction on a simulated social network and discussion of issues of privacy, cyberbullying, hate speech, truthfulness, biases, in connection with content related to school subjects

- Since 2015: 3000+ students, 200+ teachers
- 280 master students in Education Sciences have used project's material

- A 3-D virtual teen-aged character to attract youngsters to informatics as a science
